Application

Ideal for carpet bonding, also bonds most other materials such as Formica, rubber, cork, leather, fiberglass, polyurethane foam, EVA to wood, metal or concrete.

Application Direction

- 1. Surfaces must be clean, dry and free of dirt, grease, oil or water.
- 2. Stir adhesive before use.
- Apply the adhesive to both surfaces to be bonded with a dry, clean brush or scraper to give a uniform coating.
- 4. Allow the solvents to evaporate until the adhesive film is touch dry. It will take between 5 to 20 minutes depending upon surface porosity and weather condition.
- 5. Position the coated surfaces accurately before assemble them. Apply even pressure to consolidate the bond.
